As a Peer Support Volunteer you can:

What's involved?

- Volunteer for at least 1 x 5 hour shift each month (either from home, our city-based Resource Centre or our new Geelong peer support hub) on a Monday, Wednesday or Thursday.
- Complete an online, self-paced training course and mentoring with experienced Peer Support Volunteers.
- Attend an in-person orientation day in Melbourne on 3 June or Geelong on 16 June.
